this camp to teach English. Youth from the local church Rebecca plus about 40 youth from the village participated. Each day, the leaders shared the message of the Gospel.

"Already on the second day of the camp, we had a lot of opportunities to talk about spiritual things with the campers," Stojce says. "We were amazed by what the Lord was doing."

Sampan is 70 years old. He still remembers when he heard the Gospel for the first time. "I heard about Jesus when Ruth came to my village," he says. "That was on November 12, 2020." Ruth and her team are Reach A Village ministry partners.



A few weeks later, Sampan began having problems with his eyesight. The condition grew worse rapidly. He suffered all the time with double vision, dizziness and headaches. The doctors told him surgery might fix his problems, but there were no guarantees.

A local believer shared Bible stories with Sampan. especially stories about the healing touch of Jesus. He reminded Sampan that Jesus has the power to heal mental, physical and spiritual illnesses.

"I didn't want surgery on my eyes because it was expensive, and it scared me," Sampan says. "So instead, I reached out to Jesus, I said, 'Jesus, I have a problem with my eyes. Please help me!"

Jesus did help Sampan! The next day after that prayer, he began seeing clearly. His double vision was gone. "Now, I tell everyone what Jesus has done for me," he says. "I have told almost everyone in my village how Jesus has healed me, and that Jesus can help them, too."
