When I began to tell her about Jesus, she said she wanted to know more."

Today, Carmelita and her family host a Bible study group in their home for their neighbors and relatives. "My life changed because of what I learned from Pastor Crisanto's teaching," Carmelita says. "I want everyone I know to hear about Jesus."
