DISCIPLING NEW BELIEVERS POLAND

Nikodem* is one of more than 100,000 people who are prison inmates in Poland. Since 2010, he has been serving a life sentence.

Before going to prison, Nikodem was involved in debt collection, extor-

tion and human trafficking. Thinking that the most important thing in life was for people to fear him, he killed three people.

"When I was arrested and placed in prison, my life collapsed," Nikodem says. "Waking up every morning and seeing bars in the windows reminded me that I had ended up in a place I never wanted to be. All the evil I had done came back to me with full force."

One day, when Nikodem was outdoors on the prison grounds, a boy approached him and said, "You are not alone. God loves you." He responded by hitting the boy very hard.

While in solitary confinement, Nikodem began to pray. The boy arranged for someone to send him a Bible, and he read it every day.

Later, the boy introduced Nikodem to Darek, who visits the prison often. "I listened to Darek, and I absorbed every word he spoke about Jesus," Nikodem says. "He gave me the Gospel of John. I became friends with Jesus, and He is my Savior. Jesus gave me a new life, and now I belong to Him."
