


## OUR MISSION

## HOW GOD IS WORKING

■ The purpose of our ministries is to help transform lives so new churches are started in unreached areas. Your gifts help spread the Gospel in three ways:

### 1. Starting New Churches


Local Christian leaders receive in-depth modular training and are equipped with Scripture materials to take the Gospel into unreached areas. They build relationships, introduce people to God's Word, conduct Bible studies, and start a new church.

### 2. Children's Bible Ministry


Children are introduced to Jesus and study God's Word through school outreach, Vacation Bible Schools, summer camp programs and children's Bible study groups.

### 3. Discipling New Believers

We come alongside established local churches to provide training and Scripture materials to begin Bible studies for evangelism and discipleship outreach. Three interconnected components are key to transforming the lives of adults and children with the Gospel: Scriptures, Training and Local Leaders.





Thank you for coming alongside us in this mission so that more people can find true freedom in Jesus Christ!



[Please note that this is the 2019 average, and some ministry areas vary in terms of their response to the Gospel and ministry cost.]





## A HISTORIC DAY

■ The movement of God in Thailand continues to grow phenomenally. This year, 6,019 Thai people chose to commit their lives to Jesus Christ. These photos were taken in January 2019, when our ministry partners the Free in Jesus Christ Church Association (FJCCA) and Dwight Martin from Reach A Village baptized 520 new believers. To our knowledge, nothing of this magnitude had ever taken place in Thailand before!



Local Thai Christians took the Gospel to 192 villages that had not heard about Jesus and started house churches. The number of new believers is multiplying as those who have found freedom in Christ can't keep it to themselves; they just have to go and tell others. The Holy Spirit's fire is starting to spread throughout this country!

## THE POWER OF A LOCAL LEADER

■ Reach A Village partners with ministries around the world to train and equip local Christian leaders to help grow God's Kingdom. Through these partnerships, thousands of local workers are reaching the unreached people of their countries.

In Poland, one of those local leaders is Derek. Coming to faith in Christ was a long journey for him. He attempted to end his life three times.

Determined to succeed on his third attempt, Derek traveled into the woods with a noose in his backpack. He climbed a tree and put the noose around his neck. Just as he was about to jump, he heard a voice in his head say, "Why do you not ask me for help?" He didn't realize at the time that it was Jesus.

He started reading the Bible and saw the effect Jesus had on the lives of people He encountered. Derek recalls, "I fell down on my knees crying because I understood my sinfulness and what Jesus has done for me." As a new Christian, he began meeting with other believers and felt a passion to share the Gospel.

As Derek's faith grew, he answered God's call to serve in Poland's prisons.

With the training that our partners in Poland provide, he learned how to teach them God's Word through evangelistic Bible studies. Inmates are coming to Jesus and inviting others to join them. Derek and our Polish ministry partners have reached hundreds of inmates!

"God used the difficulties in my life so that I would be able to help others in depression," Derek states.

"Now with sharing the Gospel, I have stopped worrying. I learn how to sow and water the seeds, and then I leave the rest to God."

# OUR MINISTRIES

## STARTING NEW CHURCHES



Teodora is working to start a new church in Serbia. One day, while traveling by taxi, she met Katarina. As they talked, Teodora realized that Katarina hungered to know more about the Gospel.

Before that taxi ride ended, Katarina invited Teodora to her home to talk further. As they prayed and read the Bible together, Teodora's faith touched Katarina deeply. She wished that her faith had been as strong during her life.

Born into a traditional Serbian family, Katarina married when she was young. The couple suffered many disappointments as their relationship deteriorated. They had one child together, but Katarina could not find a way to fill the emptiness in her heart.

When Katarina learned that she had breast cancer, she finally turned to God in desperation. She bought a Bible and was baptized. But still she had no peace.

Now, Katarina is learning a lot from Teodora. She understands the Bible more than she ever has. She feels at peace because of her confident hope in Christ.

## DISCIPLINING NEW BELIEVERS



"Nothing was more important to me than money, not even my wife," says Myint. As a hardworking businessperson in Myanmar, he had much success and appeared happy. But on the inside, he was falling apart.

One night, Myint felt a sudden, intense pain in his stomach. He fell to the floor in agony. His wife and children rushed him to the hospital. "I thought my life was ending," he says. "I knew I had followed my flesh into evil. And I was afraid about what was coming next."

That night, Myint cried out to God. The pain drove him to open a Bible. When he read Matthew 6, God revealed to him the dangers of storing up treasures on earth.

The doctors soon diagnosed a problem with his gall bladder. God diagnosed a problem with his priorities.

"God used physical pain to save me from the eternal pain of judgment," Myint says. "He broke me down. I began to understand God's plan of salvation."

God sent Pastor Thida to invite Myint to Bible study and house church meetings. There, Myint heard the Gospel. He already knew what life without Christ was like. Because of faithful believers, he began to learn about life with Christ.

## CHILDREN'S BIBLE MINISTRY

Many people in his Cambodian village knew Keo Leang as a gang member. He gambled, was disobedient and began fights everywhere he went – at only the age of 13. He was suffering, and so were his parents.

One day in the village, Keo Leang met Charya, who was smiling and carrying a book in his hand. He spoke to Keo Leang: "Brother, I see your face is not happy."

"Why are you so friendly to me? I'm a desperate, bad person," Keo Leang responded.

"We are all sinful people," Charya stated. "But we can find new life in Christ Jesus."

"What is this new life you are talking about?" Keo Leang asked him.

Then Charya explained about God's love for us, salvation in Jesus Christ and abundant life as a follower of Jesus. Keo Leang was completely amazed by God's grace. That day, he accepted Jesus as his personal Lord and Savior.

Today, Charya and Keo Leang meet often to study the Bible together. Keo Leang also attends a Sunday meeting of believers to learn more about following Jesus.

"Because of Jesus, I'm building a new life," Keo Leang says. "I want to be an example of faith for my family and the people of my village."

# RESEARCH AND MAPPING

Reach A Village is on the cutting edge of making sure that everyone has an opportunity to hear the Good News and find freedom in Jesus. That requires research and knowing where the unreached villages are located.

Following Jesus' example of moving from village to village led to the development of the Harvest database and dynamic nationwide maps showing church locations and places that do not have churches. During the past year, we helped develop


these tools for another Southeast Asian country, bringing the total to five countries.

Reach A Village is also deeply engaged in the mobilization and training of those being sent out to establish churches. The Firstfruits database and app were developed to help local workers increase their effectiveness by tracking their activities, events and their interaction with the people reached as they share the Gospel in each village.




The maps below show the progression of church growth in Central Thailand. This data has been collected through the Harvest Database research compiled by Dwight Martin.









In April, the Christianity Today cover story "Making Missions Count" featured Reach A Village ministries and the Harvest database, which was developed by team member Dwight Martin to aid the Thai Church's efforts to reach their entire country for Christ. The article explained how this real-time data has played a key role for our Thai ministry partners, the Free in Jesus Christ Church Association, in making strategic plans and tracking the explosive growth of their movement to start churches in unreached villages.

Bob Craft shared that our Cambodia team is also using the Harvest database as a tool in their national plan. He believes that they could have a church started in every village throughout the country within five years.

We want these tools to serve all ministries trying to reach villages with the Gospel for the first time. It is our desire to continue developing tools that will help national Christian leaders create biblical strategies to saturate their countries with the Gospel. We want to see a church in every village and every believer equipped with Scriptures to grow in the grace and knowledge of the Lord.
